

The Illinois Kidney Care Alliance is a coalition of organizations, community groups and advocates, health professionals, and businesses from across Illinois banding together to ensure that patients' needs come first.

Currently, more than **785,000 Americans** suffer from kidney failure. Of these, about **70 percent** are on dialysis, while the rest are able to survive with a functioning kidney transplant. The incidence rate of kidney failure is expected to rise in the U.S. in over the next decade — and is higher among African-Americans, Latinos and people of color than among whites.
